

Eligibility for Associate Membership

- An organization or individual that does not operate a franchised new car dealership in California may apply to become an associate member of CNCDA.
- Applications for associate membership will not be accepted from:
 - vehicle manufacturers;
 - o vehicle manufacturer-affiliated lenders;
 - individuals or organizations that compete with franchised new car dealers for customers in the areas of vehicle sales and/or service;
 - o individuals or organizations that have a history of filing civil actions against dealerships; or
 - o individuals or organizations that have interests generally adverse to the franchised new car dealer business.
- Applications are subject to approval by the CNCDA Board of Directors.

Terms of Associate Membership

- Associate members are not entitled to use CNCDA's name and/or logo in advertisements or other materials.
- Associate members cannot reproduce or repurpose materials, publications, or other content developed by CNCDA without
 express written permission from CNCDA.
- Associate membership may be revoked at any time at the discretion of the CNCDA Board of Directors and/or the President.
